This house will be located approximately 400 feet from the first house (ARB meeting of July 19, 2005).

The ARB generally approved of the proposed design drawing, with the following revisions:

- The chimney is shown at two heights. This issue will be resolved. The chimney should be above peak level.
- On the rear elevation, the three windows on the first floor in the dining room should be mullioned together, not separated as shown on the drawing.
- On the front elevation, the siding should match the vinyl siding. It is not brick, as currently shown on the drawing.
- The concrete foundation should be lowered to no more than 18 inches above ground.
- The columns on the deck on the front elevation should be 8 inch fiberglass or wood wrapped 4 x 4s.
- Left elevation: The applicant will check to see if 6" corner boards are available. They are currently proposed to be 4". If not, they will remain at 4".

The applicant will note colors and materials on the drawings before submitting to the Building Department.
