In the meeting of December 20, 2005, the ARB recommended the following modifications to the proposed application:

- The drawings should more accurately reflect width of the panels (in the structure itself). In particular, the drawings should show the "expansion joints"
- The drawings should more accurately reflect the "pan-tone warm red" which is the proposed color
- The landscaping along the front row should be changed from deciduous trees to a mix of flowering trees with deciduous and possibly evergreen trees to aid with the screening of the structure.
- The applicant should present a lighting plan.
- The proposed horizontal painted line should be carried across the southeast elevation (the paint, not the material).

The applicant submitted revised drawings that reflected all of the recommendations above.
