## 4) Putnam Federal Credit Union- Wall Sign Review

The Credit Union proposes to reconfigure the existing interior space and to sawcut a new entrance. This will involve replacement of the existing mullions with full length mullions, insertion of a new door and aluminum enhancement to match existing. The applicant presented, in color photographs of the entire façade of the building. The applicant proposed to match the existing materials which include aluminum duronitic.

Modifications: The Board requested the following changes to the proposed application:

- -The panel should remain consistent all across.
- -The proposed glass side-light panel will be eliminated to be consistent with existing.
- -The block at the bottom of the door will not be cut. The cut line will only be to the door.

# 6) Mount Ebo Lot 6- Review of Proposed Senior Housing Structures Representatives:

The ARB recommended the following modifications to the proposed application:

- The two-foot overhang, as depicted on the colored rendering of the front elevation, should be incorporated into the architectural design (Drawing A4-1, Exterior Elevations). The applicant indicated that in order to include this overhang, the overall height of the buildings would increase by a mean of 1 foot, which would exceed the Town Code height requirement of 45 feet. The applicant indicated that they would pursue a variety of options in order to include this feature.
- The column architecture depicted on the colored rendering of the front elevation should be incorporated into the proposed design and shown on the architectural drawings (Drawing A4-1, Exterior Elevations).
- Side elevations of the clubhouse should be included in future submissions.
