### HOURS OF OPERATION

Markel Park: Monday through Friday - 9:00 am to 4:30 pm -Pool open at NOON  
Saturday and Sunday - 12 Noon to 5:00 pm

Tonetta Lake: Monday through Friday = Noon to 7:00 pm  
Saturday and Sunday - 11:00 am to 7:00 pm

Opens Memorial Weekend for weekends only until June 24<sup>th</sup>.  
Noon to 5:00 p.m.

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Recreation Parks are for the use of the RESIDENTS of the Town of Southeast. The following rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all users. They have been established to assure safe and sanitary operation of all facilities. All persons are to obey the rules, regulations and instructions at all times. Parents are requested to read and explain these rules to their children and caution them to observe all rules. Any failure to comply with these rules shall be considered sufficient cause for immediate suspension of privileges of the offending person and may also be considered sufficient cause for the cancellation of IDENTIFICATION CARD.

### GENERAL RULES

1. Each resident must present his identification card at the entrance when entering the Recreation area.  
No one will be allowed through the gate without his CARD even if known by the attendant in charge.  
When requested by the attendant other proper identification must be shown.
2. Permitting anyone to use your card will be sufficient cause for revoking it for the season.
3. The Director and the Recreation Leader should be notified immediately upon loss of identification card. Application for a replacement should be made at the Recreation Office. There will be a charge of \$10.00.
4. All persons using any of the recreation facilities do so at their own risk. The Town Board will NOT be responsible for any accident or injury.
5. The Town Board will NOT be responsible for loss or damage to any personal property.
6. All persons using the recreation facilities shall observe such rules as posted in the area.
7. All food or other refreshments must be consumed in the designated area ONLY.
8. NO INTOXICANTS may be brought into or consumed in the area.
9. No abusive language shall be used.
10. No PETS are allowed in the recreation areas.
11. Park groups planning any activities at the recreation areas must obtain permission from the Director of Parks & Recreation.
12. Admission to the Beach area shall be refused to anyone with colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, Infections or wearing bandages.
13. Boat launching is not allowed off Town Property.
14. SPECIAL GUEST PERMITS: Each family unit may purchase at any time only ONE set of ten reduced prices passes at \$25.00 when they have purchased their season pass. For additional guests, regular daily admission fees will apply. ***RESIDENTS MUST ACCOMPANY GUESTS!*** *Guests (five per day) are permitted with residents who hold a season's pass.* **WITHOUT A SEASON'S PASS YOU ARE NOT ENTITLED TO BRING GUESTS.**  
SENIOR CITIZEN GUEST PASS - ONE set of ten reduced price passes at \$25.00 for "GRANDCHILDREN ONLY"
15. **NO SMOKING ON THE BEACH. WE NOW HAVE A DESIGNATED SMOKING AREA.**
16. No Floatation devices permitted. Zip-up preserves and swimmies are permitted in the roped area.
17. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an Adult 21 years of age
18. Children over 16 years of age must have proof of residency. School ID with address and/or Report card.
