Condominium and Townhouse Schedule

RECYCLING IS MANDATORY

Recyclable materials must be available for collection by 6:00 am

Newspapers, magazines, phone books,
junk mail, corrugated cardboard
(including **Pizza Boxes**) and commingled recyclables
(glass, cans and plastic)

Please see your scheduled pick-up day.

PAPER: Newspapers, magazines, phone books, junk mail and other paper products may be commingled and tied with cord in bundles not higher than 10 inches. Corrugated cardboard must be broken down, cut, separated and bundled not higher than 10 inches and not wider than 36 inches in either direction; also tied with cord. The recycling pickup schedule will be observed during inclement weather.

COMMINGLED recyclables, such as glass bottles, aluminum, tin & metal cans, foil and pie plates and plastic containers (numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 as specified on containers only) must be rinsed. They can be commingled in clear or blue tinted recycling bags. Recycling bags are available at most local supermarkets.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Putnam County Hazardous waste clean-up days will be held by the Putnam County Health Department on one Saturday in the Spring and one Saturday in the fall. (dates to be announced by PCDOH)

CHRISTMAS TREE PICKUP

Christmas trees (excluding artificial) will be picked up your associations designated area on the following Wednesdays during January – 1/11/12 and 1/18/12. The 2013 Christmas tree pick-up will be 1/9/13 and 1/16/13.

EPA recommends that consumers take advantage of recycling options for **compact fluorescent light bulbs** containing mercury. Spent bulbs should be carefully placed in a separate recycling bag for proper removal by the carter.

2012 RECYCLING OPTIONS

Cardboard & Paper Only

What must be Recycled?

- ✓ Newspapers
- ✓ Office Paper/Envelopes
- ✓ Shredded Paper (must be placed in clear or blue bag)
- ✓ Magazines & Junk Mail
- ✓ Phone & Paperback Books
- ✓ Cardboard Boxes & Packaging
 - i.e. cereal boxes, pizza boxes, pasta boxes, shoe boxes etc...
- ✓ Shipping / Appliance boxes (including corrugated)

How are these items to be prepared for pick up?

Choose any or a combination of the following:

- Place Items directly in your existing recycle bin (sample photo 1) or an old clearly labeled garbage pail (sample photo 2). Do not bundle or bag items. ***This is the Preferred method.***
OR
- Create a bundle; Tie newspapers and other materials into bundles string or twine, no higher than 10 inches high and 36 inches long or put in a paper bag. (sample photo 3)

Commingled Glass, Cans & Plastics

What must be Recycled?

- ✓ Glass Jars & Bottles (clear and colored)
- ✓ Foil Pie Plates, Foil Containers and Aluminum Foil
- ✓ Metal Bottle Caps
- ✓ Metal Cans including empty aerosol cans
- ✓ Plastic containers #1-7
 - Plastic Bags and Carry Out Bags, (including dry cleaner bags), may be dropped off at any of several large grocery or retail stores for recycling.

How are these items to be prepared for pick up?

Choose any or a combination of the following:

- Place Items directly in your existing recycle bin (sample photo A) or an old clearly labeled garbage pail (sample photo B). Do not bag any items. ***This is the Preferred method.***
OR
- Place items in recycling bags and put bag out for collection. (sample photo C)

BULK PICK-UP

Associations and Management Companies communicate specific dates for your bulk pick-up.

Please contact your associate/management company contact directly to inquire dates.

The following items are NOT included for bulk pickup:

Paint	Chemicals	Liquids
Masonry	Stone	Brick
Batteries	Tires	Propane Tanks
Lumber	Boiler	Hot Water Tank
Renovation or Construction Debris		

NOTE: Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or any other appliance containing Freon must be de-charged and tagged by a State authorized specialist. Consult the yellow pages for a professional under "**Refrigerator and Freezers – Dealers and Service**".

The Carter will not pick up such items without such certification.

Tires can be disposed of through local auto repair shops at a nominal charge.

The resident, before disposal, must remove doors on any appliance that presents a hazard for children.

In 2012, AAA Carting & Rubbish Removal, Inc. will provide household waste collection, recycling, and bulk services for the Town of Southeast at a reduced rate.

We ask everyone to take advantage of the second garbage pickup available each week. Currently 70% of all garbage is placed in dumpsters for the first pick-up available each week. Taking advantage of the second day will result in improved service and efficiencies on a weekly basis.

Please take note of the following change: electronics must be recycled. They will not be picked up with regular weekly refuse or bulk pick-up service. A list of acceptable items are listed inside this flyer.

Residents can also recycle shredded paper by placing it in clear plastic or paper bag(s). It is required to have the shreds secured when they are disposed of to eliminate the chance of being blown around the neighborhood.
